

Volunteer and/or Employee Driver Pledge

As a volunteer and/or employee for Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project, I understand that my safety and the safety of others is paramount. I understand that driving as a volunteer and/or employee is a privilege, not a right, and therefore, I agree to:

1. Provide evidence of my current status as a licensed driver in California.
2. Provide evidence of auto insurance for any vehicle I might drive while I am serving as a volunteer and/or employee driver for Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project.
3. Comply with all of Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project's policies and procedures and any directions provided by my supervisor.
4. Comply with all laws and regulations concerning driving, including laws pertaining to the use of seat belts, child safety seats, cell phone use, and speed limits.
5. Promptly notify my supervisor of any physical conditions, vehicle defects, or road conditions that might affect my safety or the safety of those I am driving.
6. Notify my supervisor of any traffic citations I receive—even if given while driving on my personal time.
7. Attend driver training at the request of Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project

And, if involved in an accident, I agree to complete an Accident Report provided by Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project and to cooperate with the police, my supervisor, and Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project's insurer, its insurance adjusters, and attorneys.

I pledge that if I drive my own vehicle on behalf of Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project, I will maintain adequate personal auto insurance. I also understand that as a volunteer and/or employee driver, my personal auto insurance will be activated for any accidents or incidents that involve my vehicle, including those that occur while I am serving as a volunteer and/or employee driver for Santa Barbara Alternatives to Violence Project.
